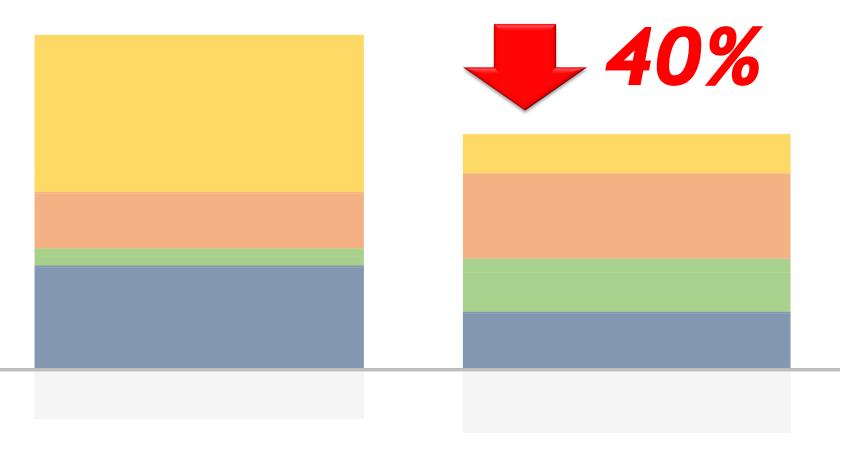

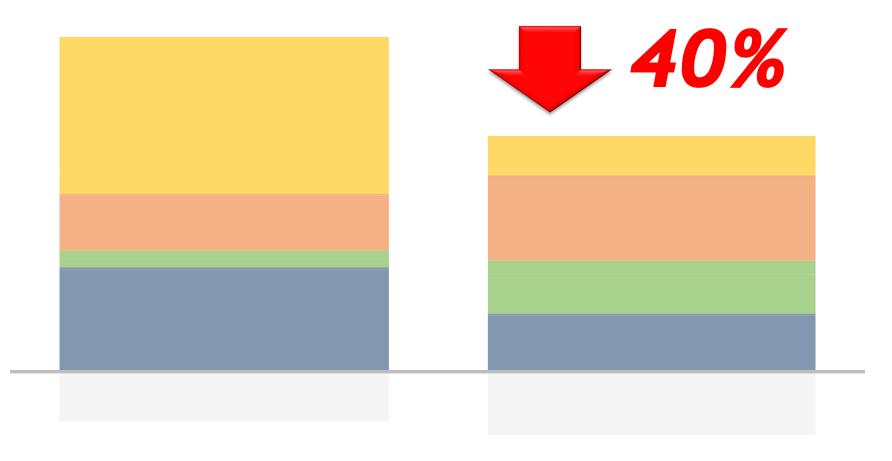

Executive Order 13 Update

Highlights:

- Sec. 1: PNP and NBI in coordination with DOJ, DILG,
 DICT to intensify fight against illegal gambling
- Sec. 2: All gambling activities and services related to or in support of such activities <u>conducted</u> <u>beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the government</u> <u>authority which issued the license shall be dealt as</u> <u>illegal gambling</u>



Executive Order 13 Update

Highlights:

-Sec. 3: Any gambling operator desiring to operate outside the jurisdiction of the government authority which issued its existing license shall apply for a separate license with the appropriate authority.

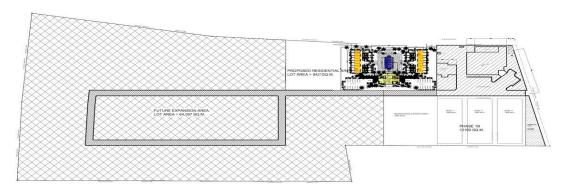

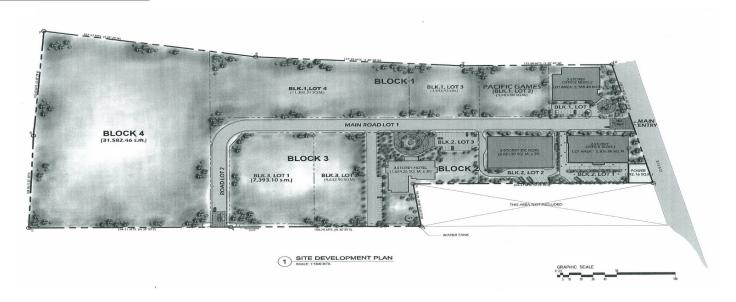
PEZA:

Cyberpark Planned Phases

- Phase 1A Completion of the Cyberpark Building 1 & 2 renovation and ready for turnover to a new locator, Empire Group
- Phase 1B Proposed Development of Commercial and Residential Area
 - Construct a Data Center estimated cost of P300M at 50 rack capacity
 - Construct 2-3 storey buildings with gross floor area of 4,500 sq.m. each
 - Provide area for park and recreational facilities
 - Construct residential units (30 container type units)
- Future Phase Development of the Remaining 64,000 sq.m.
 - Divide the area into 3 super blocks of ~2 hectares
 - Each super block has a buildable land area of ~14,000 sq.m.
 - Provide road network and utilities as required

Cagayan North International Airport



- 2.1km long runway with a CAAP approved a Temporary Aerodrome Registration 3C up to November 12, 2017
- On-Going Works:
 - PAPI Lights, RESA, Strip Width, Air Traffic Console, Weather Equipment
- First Chartered Flight from Macau expected on Third Quarter, 2017

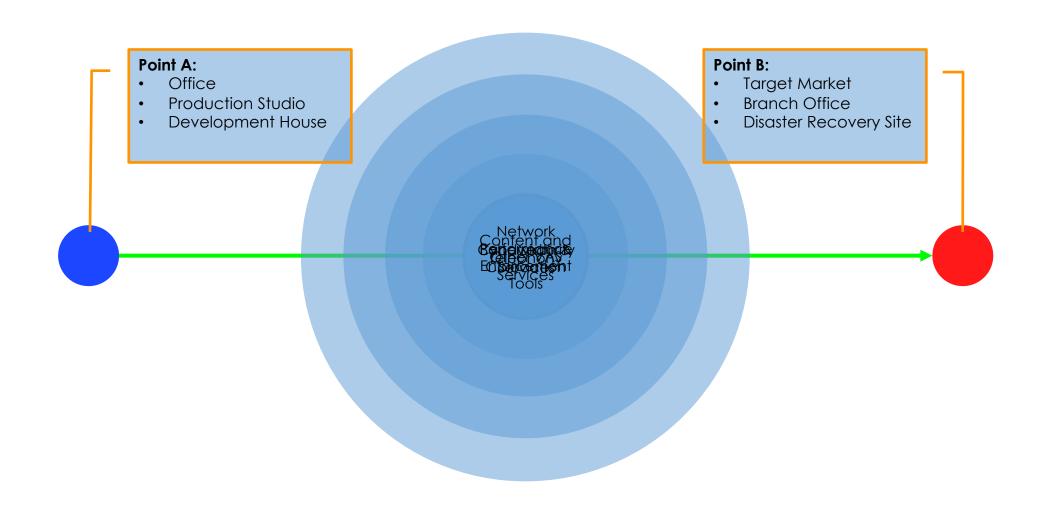

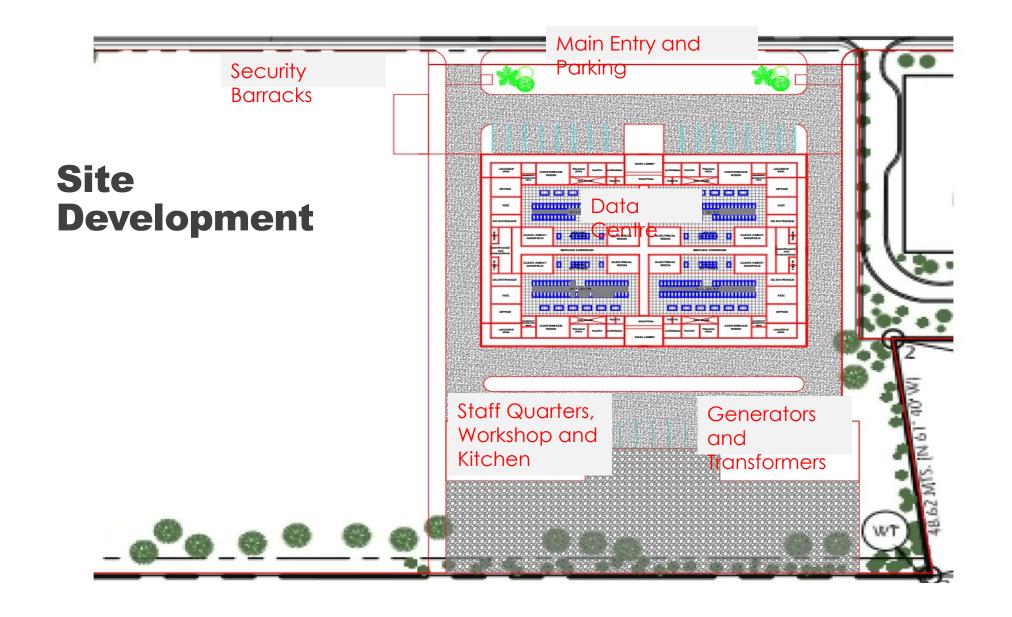

Service Catalog

Network Services

- 1. IP Transit or Global Internet Access (GIA) via Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) and multiple network-to-network-interfaces (NNI) with Tier 1 providers.
- 2. Domestic Local Loop (DLL)
- 3. International Private Leased Circuit (IPLC)
- 4. Direct Routes: bespoke layer 2 or 3 services to Europe, China, Cambodia, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Korea, Malaysia, Japan, and others.
- 5. Clean Pipe Service: zero backholing of circuits with guaranteed data throughputs.
- 6. Content Delivery Networks (CDN): CDN to multiple global destinations.
- 7. Network Performance Enforcer (NPE) service through a Customer-Premise Equipment (CPE) allowing fully-outsourced, off-net, 24x7 network monitoring services for up to layer 7 management. Includes layer 7 DDoS detection and mitigation. Takes the place of 24x7 by 52 weeks of shifting Network Engineers.

Data Center Services

- Colocation: through multiple high-performance data centers in the Philippines, with options for Disaster Recovery and/or High Availability sites across Asia and Europe.
- 2. Full looking glass and remote hands services across all data center sites.
- 3. Infrastructure as a Service: hardware leasing and management services.
- 4. *Virtual Private Cloud (VPC): dedicated and secure cloud services with local and offshore instances.

Security Services

- 1. Secure Domain Name Servers (Hardened ANS and recursive DNS): website security and acceleration, protection against DNS poisoning, DNS DDoS, malware and viruses, among others.
- 2. DDoS Detection and Mitigation: complete on-premise and cloud solution with multiple Tbps and PPS of mitigation capacity.
- 3. Vulnerability assessment: website scans, code audits, penetration testing, and infrastructure security audits.
- 4. Anti-phishing, spoofing and website takedown services: mitigation and takedown of fake websites.

Other Services

- 1. Licensed China TV Box: over 120 channels of licensed content from China, to include live/broadcast TV.
- 2. Telephony Services: DID, ITFS, VoIP, IVRS, ACD, and others.
